Camp Take Charge, located in Massanetta Springs, VA, offers adolescents and teens with diabetes (ages 11-16) four days and three nights of summer fun and social connections. Camp Take Charge is sponsored by Brainy Camps of Children's National Medical Center. Our camp provides opportunities for teens to gain confidence, build self-esteem, become better self managers, and establish social connections with other adolescents, teens, and staff who live with the condition. At Camp Take Charge of Diabetes, teens share the experience of being part of a team, while learning and having fun in a safe and supportive environment.

Program

Campers participate and choose from activities including team sports, hiking, arts and crafts, canoeing, a low and high ropes confidence course, camp Olympics, swimming, yoga, and drama. Support groups and educational programs promote knowledge, skill development and social connections. At Camp Take Charge, adolescents and teens gain a better understanding of their condition, through knowledge, support, and social connections.

Staff

The staff of Take Charge of Diabetes Camp's staff includes a physician, social worker and physical therapist, nurse and psychologist from Children's National Medical Center in addition to trained counselors carefully selected for their genuine interest in children and teens. Many counselors are college students and professionals with diabetes. Campers benefit from their experience, knowledge and understanding.

For only \$450 per camper, children experience four days and three nights of overnight camp filled with adventure, laughter and friendships. The air-conditioned cabins offer comfortable beds and bath houses in a village setting that encourages an interactive group experience.
