Camp Heart Beat of Brainy Camps, located in Massanetta Springs, VA, offers children and teens with pacemakers, ICDs, and arrhythmias (ages 9-16) four days and three nights of summer fun and social connections. Camp Heart Beat is sponsored by Brainy Camps of Children's National Medical Center. Camp Heart Beat provides opportunities for children to build self-esteem, gain independence, and establish social connections with other children and staff who live with the condition. At camp, children share the experience of being part of a team, while learning and having fun in a safe, exciting, and supportive environment.



Program

Campers participate and choose from activities including team sports, hiking, arts and crafts, canoeing, a low and high ropes confidence course, camp Olympics, swimming, yoga, and drama. Support groups and educational programs promote knowledge, skill development and social connections. At Camp Heart Beat, children and teens gain a better understanding of their condition, strengths, and self-worth.

Staff

Camp Heart Beat staff includes a comprehensive team consisting of a pediatric cardiologist, social worker, physical therapist, nurse and psychologist from Children's National Medical Center, in addition to trained counselors carefully selected for their genuine interest in children and teens. Many counselors are college students and professionals with heart conditions. Campers benefit from their experience, knowledge and understanding.



Registration Information

For only \$450 per camper, children experience four days and three nights of overnight camp filled with adventure, laughter and friendships. The air conditioned cabins offer comfortable beds in a rustic village setting. Payment plans and a limited number of scholarships are available to eligible campers. Camp Heart Beat will make a strong effort to accommodate any child who wants to attend.
