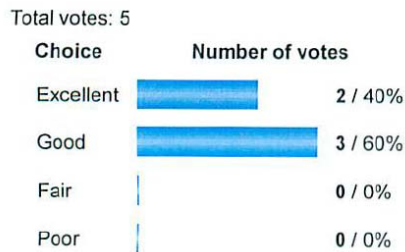

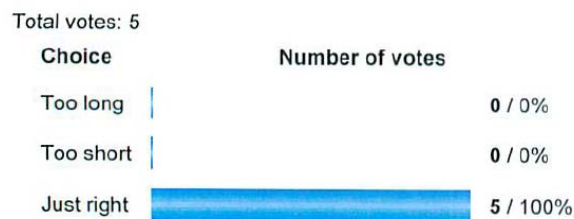
Evaluation Results

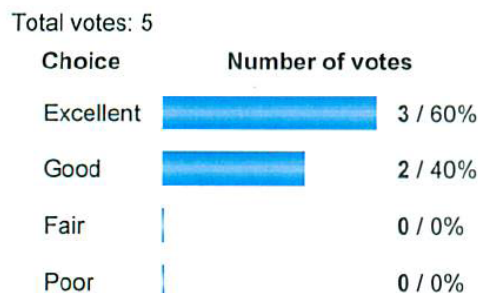
Question 1: What is your overall impression of today's webinar?



Question 2: What is your overall impression of time allotted for the webinar?



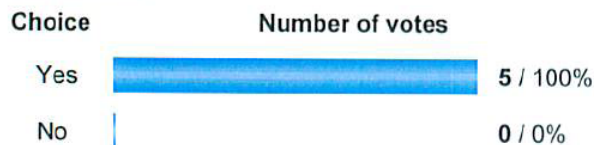
Question 3: What is your overall impression of the presentation of the information?





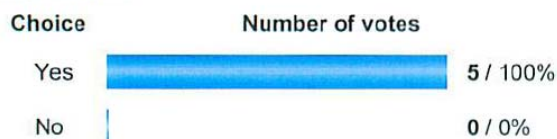
Question 4: Did you find the information helpful?
