

## **Program Update regarding PM 67**

For EMT-Basic Providers, acceptable forms of supporting documentation to submit to the EMSC Program for review and consideration as having met PM67 may include the State/Territory's regulation which states that EMT-Basic recertification requirements include the successful completion of an EMT-Basic Refresher course that includes pediatric education modules or may require the use of the U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration EMT-Basic Refresher: **National Standard Curriculum**.

For EMT-Intermediate Providers, acceptable forms of supporting documentation to submit to the EMSC Program for review and consideration as having met PM67 may include the State/Territory's regulation which states that EMT-Intermediate recertification requirements include the successful completion of an EMT-Intermediate Refresher course which includes pediatric education modules or may require the use of the U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration **EMT-Intermediate REFRESHER: National Standard Curriculum**. Please note that for performance measures, intermediate providers are considered advanced life support (ALS) providers.

For EMT-Paramedics, acceptable forms of supporting documentation to submit to the EMSC Program for review and consideration as having met PM67 may include the State/Territory's regulation which states that EMT-Paramedic recertification requirements include the successful completion of an EMT-Paramedic Refresher course that includes pediatric education modules or may require the use of the U.S. Department of Transportation's National Highway Traffic Safety Administration **EMT-Paramedic REFRESHER: National Standard Curriculum**.
